Remark:

The Civil Aviation Agency has the right to change dates of theoretical examinations and has the obligation of timely notification about the changes.

xx – dates when theoretical exams can be taken

yy – the latest date up to which applications could be submitted to the Civil Aviation Agency (application forms with all additional documentation) (e.g. the candidate who submitted application with stamp date of CAA later than 04.01.2022 cannot take exams from 24.01.2022 - 27.01.2022, he/she can take exams on future designated dates).

The candidate can take the exam only when he/she has CAA approval in written form for taking such an exam (if you are not sure if you have such approval check with the Head of Training in your flight school). The candidate has the obligation to contact the CAA in order to get the specific schedule (time) for dates on which he is interested to take exams.

The candidate is allowed to choose the subject that he/she wants to take at the exam.

4 consecutive working days = 1 sitting
1 appearance on examination = 1 attempt
1 day – 1 candidate – 1 appearance

(During one day that is scheduled for examinations one candidate can take examination only once)

(This means that the candidate who took a specific subject and failed to pass it can not take the same subject again on that same day, but he/she can take any other examinations for other licences/ratings provided that he/she has written approval and has made a previous announcement)

PPL – candidate has in total 4 attempts in 18 months, including the re-exam (subsequent attempts to pass a failed subject).

CPL – 4 consecutive working days are 1 sitting, regardless of how many times the candidate has actually taken the exams (on one, two, three or all four days). The candidate is entitled to 6 sittings.
(1 subject = 4 attempts / 18 months)

ATPL - 4 consecutive working days are 1 sitting, regardless of how many times the candidate actually took the exams (on one, two, three or all four days). The candidate is entitled to 6 sittings.
(1 subject = 4 attempts / 18 months)

IR - 4 consecutive working days are 1 sitting, regardless of how many times candidate has actually taken the exams (on one, two, three or all four days). The candidate is entitled to 6 sittings.
(1 subject = 4 attempts / 18 months)

For re-exam the candidate has to submit application on the form together with tax receipt.

For additional examination dates for theoretical knowledge (for first attempt and re-exam) the candidate has to submit an application form. Once such additional date is approved the candidate has to submit the tax receipt when taking the exam.

BE CAREFUL!

The applicant's identity shall be established before the beginning of the exam

Taking exams on additional dates for CPL, ATPL, IR is considered as 1 whole sitting!

Taking exams on additional dates for PPL and all other licences and ratings is considered as 1 attempt!
